\sim April Meeting Recap \sim



With the help of Tulare Public Library staff, especially Brittny Stout, our April speaker, James Baker, came to us LIVE via Zoom! It was a first for our Society but not the last, as Program Chair Dan Van Weerdhuizen already has two more in the works for this year!

Mr. Baker's topic was "Google: The Genealogist's Best Friend", and his presentation was full of tips on how to use Google as a special tool for genealogical research. First off he mentioned that Legacy Family Tree Webinars has over 1700 webinars, divided into about ten categories, and one of

those categories (with 30 classes) is on Google. He said that Google-sponsored You Tube is another place to check out as there are several hundred presentations there that deal specifically with genealogy related topics.



During his discussion Mr. Baker touched on several tools and features of Google that are useful to genealogists, such as Google Images, Google Books, Google Translate, Google Maps (and Earth and Street View), Google Search and Google Advanced Search. He also suggested using Google Alerts, as that can be a real time saver. Rather than continually checking back for new data on a specific topic, by using this feature Google will alert you when new information has been added about that topic. Google can also be used as finding tool for obituaries, and as a search engine to go to Wikipedia. He thinks Wikipedia is useful in genealogy due to its crowdsourcing feature, which tends to keep data on a topic relatively current.

Annual Meeting Is On May 5th!

Due to the Covid Pandemic we were unable to hold Annual Meetings in either 2020 or 2021, so this upcoming Annual Meeting is an especially important one with two important items of business that need to be brought before the membership for a vote. **The first one** is the nomination and subsequent election of members to fill four positions on the Board of Directors. One is a vacancy created by the moving out of state last December of Board member Tanya Placencia. The other three are due to the terms expiring of current Board members Elvina Fernandez, Rochelle Miguel, and Lorene Clark.

In normal years Board members are elected to serve for three-year terms. Anyone elected next month will therefore serve from June 2022 through May 2025. Board elections are supposed to be staggered so that only part of the Board is elected in any given year, and so to achieve that end the terms of current Board members Sandra Marlow and Dan Van Weerdhuizen are being extended by one year to go through May of 2023.

Any nominations received prior to the meeting will be presented that evening, and nominations can also be made from the floor at the meeting itself. Once nominations are closed the members who are present, provided that a quorum of 10 or more members is achieved, will vote to elect the new Board of Directors members. Officers for the next year are then selected by the Board at their first meeting in June.

Bylaws Changes - The other item of business is a proposed change to the Bylaws.

Background: For January and February of this year Program Chair Dan Van Weerdhuizen last fall had been able to line up a couple of good speaker prospects, but as the Society does not normally meet in December, January, and February, at the November 2021 meeting members were asked if they were interested in attending meetings the following January and/or February to hear these speakers. The general consensus was "Yes!", so Special Meetings were scheduled just for these programs.

To allow more flexibility in the future regarding whether or not to hold meetings in January and/or February (December would still be kept without a meeting), at the April 7th, 2022 Board meeting the Board approved a motion to present to the membership a proposed Bylaws change, to be voted on at the May 5th Annual Meeting. The proposed change is given below, with the text to be added printed in *Italics*:

(Add at the end of **Section 3.02 Annual and Regular Meetings - (b) Regular:**) In addition the members MAY meet on the first Thursday of January and/or February or on such days of either or both of those months as may be designated from time to time by resolution of the Board of Directors for the purpose of conducting a program related to genealogy and/or transacting proper business as may come before the membership.

For comparison here is the current section of **ARTICLE III**, Meetings of Members:

3.02 Annual and Regular Meetings - (a) Annual: The members will meet annually on the first Thursday of May in each year for the purpose of transacting proper business as may come before the meeting, and electing Directors to replace those Directors whose terms expire that year and to fill any vacancies on the Board of Directors pursuant to Section 4.11 (c) of these Bylaws. If the election of Directors does not occur at any annual meeting of the members or without a meeting by written ballot pursuant to Section 3.11 of these Bylaws, the Board will (or 5 percent of the members may) cause the election of Directors to be held at a special meeting of members called and held as soon as it is reasonably possible after the adjournment of that annual meeting of the members. If the day fixed for the annual meeting of the members falls on a legal holiday, the meeting will be held at the same hour and place on the next succeeding day.

(b) **Regular:** In addition to meeting at the annual meeting, the members shall meet on the first Thursday of March, April, June, July, August, September, October, and November in each year or on such days of each of those months as may be designated from time to time by resolution of the Board of Directors, for the purpose of conducting a program related to genealogy and transacting proper business as may come before the membership.
